### Readings

#### Psalm 99

- 1 The LORD is king; let the peoples tremble!  
He sits enthroned upon the cherubim; let the earth quake!
- 2 The LORD is great in Zion;  
he is exalted over all the peoples.
- 3 Let them praise your great and awesome name.  
Holy is he!
- 4 Mighty King, lover of justice, you have established equity; you have  
executed justice and righteousness in Jacob.
- 5 Extol the LORD our God; worship at his footstool.  
Holy is he!
- 6 Moses and Aaron were among his priests,  
Samuel also was among those who called on his name.  
They cried to the LORD, and he answered them.
- 7 He spoke to them in the pillar of cloud;  
they kept his decrees, and the statutes that he gave them.
- 8 O LORD our God, you answered them;  
you were a forgiving God to them,  
but an avenger of their wrongdoings.
- 9 Extol the LORD our God, and worship at his holy mountain;  
for the LORD our God is holy.

#### Gospel reading Luke 9: v28-36

<sup>28</sup> Now about eight days after these sayings Jesus took with him Peter and John and James, and went up on the mountain to pray. <sup>29</sup> And while he was praying, the appearance of his face changed, and his clothes became dazzling white. <sup>30</sup> Suddenly they saw two men, Moses and Elijah, talking to him. <sup>31</sup> They appeared in glory and were speaking of his departure, which he was about to accomplish at Jerusalem. <sup>32</sup> Now Peter and his companions were weighed down with sleep; but since they had stayed awake, they saw his glory and the two men who stood with him. <sup>33</sup> Just as they were leaving him, Peter said to Jesus, "Master, it is good for us to be

here; let us make three dwellings, one for you, one for Moses, and one for Elijah”—not knowing what he said. <sup>34</sup> While he was saying this, a cloud came and overshadowed them; and they were terrified as they entered the cloud. <sup>35</sup> Then from the cloud came a voice that said, “This is my Son, my Chosen; listen to him!” <sup>36</sup> When the voice had spoken, Jesus was found alone. And they kept silent and in those days told no one any of the things they had seen.
