Reading: Jeremiah 17: v5-10

- ⁵This is what the LORD says:
- "Cursed are those who put their trust in mere humans, who rely on human strength and turn their hearts away from the LORD.
- ⁶They are like stunted shrubs in the desert, with no hope for the future.

They will live in the barren wilderness, in an uninhabited salty land.

- 7 "But blessed are those who trust in the LORD and have made the LORD their hope and confidence.
- ⁸ They are like trees planted along a riverbank, with roots that reach deep into the water.

Such trees are not bothered by the heat or worried by long months of drought.

Their leaves stay green,

and they never stop producing fruit.

⁹ "The human heart is the most deceitful of all things, and desperately wicked.

Who really knows how bad it is?

¹⁰ But I, the LORD, search all hearts and examine secret motives.

I give all people their due rewards, according to what their actions deserve."

The Gospel: Hear the Gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ according to Luke **All** Glory to you, O Lord

Gospel reading: Luke 6: v17-26

¹⁷ When they came down from the mountain, the disciples stood with Jesus on a large, level area, surrounded by many of his followers and by the crowds. There were people from all over Judea and from Jerusalem and from as far north as the seacoasts of Tyre and Sidon. 18 They had come to hear him and to be healed of their diseases: and those troubled by evil spirits were healed. ¹⁹ Everyone tried to touch him, because healing power went out from him, and he healed everyone.

²⁰ Then Jesus turned to his disciples and said,

"God blesses you who are poor,

for the Kingdom of God is yours.

²¹God blesses you who are hungry now. for you will be satisfied.

God blesses you who weep now.

for in due time you will laugh.

²² What blessings await you when people hate you and exclude you and mock you and curse you as evil because you follow the Son of Man. ²³ When that happens, be happy! Yes, leap for joy! For a great reward awaits you in heaven. And remember, their ancestors treated the ancient prophets that same way.

²⁴ "What sorrow awaits you who are rich, for you have your only happiness now.

²⁵ What sorrow awaits you who are fat and prosperous now, for a time of awful hunger awaits you.

What sorrow awaits you who laugh now,

for your laughing will turn to mourning and sorrow.

²⁶ What sorrow awaits you who are praised by the crowds, for their ancestors also praised false prophets.
